








ABERNETHY WITCH HUNT WALKS



LEGEND

1. MUSEUM OF ABERNETHY Start here.

See the witches display...and much more!

2. ABERNETHY ROUND TOWER

With jougs outside, the original may have been used to restrain the accused—possibly inside the church.

3. PROVOST MAINS

Home of William Oliphant, one of the commissioners in the 1662 witch trial.

4. CAREY

Home of Jon Oliphant, one of the commissioners in the 1662 witch trial.

5. WITCHES HOLE

Approx. Just off the track up to Abernethy Law. A small cave where, according to Rev Small's 1823 account, 22 witches once gathered.

6. WITCHES GRAVES*

According to Rev Small, mass grave and execution site of a group of witches. Unlikely to be true.

*We don't recommend you climb up here!

7. WITCHES TRACK

Mentioned in Rev Small's account—probably an ancient track.
